Re: Pre-Construction Notice

Dear resident,

Construction is scheduled to begin this fall on sewer, water and storm water projects in your area. Given your proximity to the work, we want to give you a preliminary heads-up about the upcoming activities.

The construction involves two projects. The City of Everett will be replacing old sewer mains and installing a new storm drain system. The Tulalip Tribes will be installing a segment of water transmission line as part of the Tulalip Pipeline Project. Both projects will occur in the same corridor, with construction on portions of Harrison, Everett and E. Grand avenues (see map on back).

The city and the Tulalip Tribes are working closely together to minimize the duration and disruption of the projects. The current plan is to do the construction in three stages, beginning in the south and moving northward on a block-by-block basis. Here is the tentative schedule and timeline:

- Sewer main installation – October 2014 to February 2015
- Water line installation – February 2015 to May 2015
- Storm drain installation – May to August 2015

Over the next several months, we will be finalizing the construction plans. Once that is complete, the city and the Tulalip Tribes will hold an open house to provide detailed project information, explain traffic management plans and answer questions. We will notify you of the date, time and location later this summer.
